



WELCOME

If you are the guest of a member, we are delighted to welcome you to The Country Club of Florida, and hope you enjoy your visit. In order to fully enjoy the CCF experience, guests are asked to acquaint themselves with our rules, dress code and traditions.

DRESS CODE

The Country Club of Florida's Dress Codes are intended to ensure a congenial and elegant atmosphere in which to enjoy the Club's facilities and services. An integral part of our tradition is the expectation that members, their families, and guests will always be neatly attired and guided by more formal standards of appearance than may prevail in public places.

- Gentlemen shall remove hats while under any roof or on any patio with the exception of the Lifestyle Center. All hats on club property are to be worn "bill forward."
- Clothing made of blue denim is prohibited everywhere.
- Jackets and Ties may be required for Special Events.

DINING

Gentlemen: Collared shirts, Bermuda shorts or pants, and closed-toe shoes are required. Golf, tennis, and croquet attire is permitted but not fitness or athletic attire.

Ladies: Dresses, skirts, pants, shorts, leather sandals; and tennis, golf, and croquet attire are permitted. Fitness attire, rubber or plastic flip flops, fringed and ripped pants are prohibited.

GOLF

Gentlemen: Traditional collared golf shirts always tucked in, Bermuda style shorts or golf pants, golf-themed hats facing forward, and soft-spiked shoes are required.

Ladies: Collared shirts with or without sleeves, collarless shirts with sleeves; golf skirts, skorts, pants, dresses and shorts; and soft-spiked shoes are required. Short skirts and shorts, and fitness attire are prohibited.

LIFESTYLE CENTER

Appropriate fitness attire, and for safety purposes, closed-toe athletic footwear. Hats worn "bill forward." Gentlemen's shirts must have sleeves. Sandals, flip-flops, bathing suits are not permitted inside the Lifestyle Center. Men shall always wear shirts with sleeves.

POOL & CAFÉ

Bathing suits must supply appropriate coverage. Shirts may be collared or collarless. Shirts or coverups and shoes are required in the Café.

TENNIS & CROQUET

CCF maintains an “All Whites” dress code that applies to shirts, shorts, skirts, dresses, socks and includes footwear and headgear – all having no more than 10% color or trim. Gentlemen must wear a collared shirt. Warm up gear may be any color. For Croquet, trim colors may be black, red, blue or yellow.

PICKLEBALL

Footwear must have flat soles (no running shoes, cross training or similar) to prevent injury and avoid damage to the courts.

ALL COURT SPORTS

Men must wear shirts with sleeves and t-shirts should be non-offensive. Ladies are not permitted to wear halter, strapless or abbreviated tops, or short shorts/skirts.

ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY

The Club’s electronic device policy is premised on the principles of DISCRETION, DECORUM, AND COURTESY so as not to disrupt the quiet enjoyment of the Club by others. The policy is intended to preserve the traditions and peaceful tranquility of the Club for the enjoyment of all, while recognizing the needs of members to communicate electronically.

- Electronic Devices (smart phones and watches, tablets, e-readers) are to be in SILENT MODE at all times on Club property.
- **Voice Calls are strictly prohibited** everywhere on Club property, except for BRIEF and NECESSARY calls in designated areas.
- SILENT, BRIEF AND DISCREET use of electronic devices is permitted on Club property except in Dining areas, where devices are to remain invisible and kept in pockets or pocketbooks.
 - Discreet use is intended to mean use out of view of others.
 - Answering a call and then proceeding to a designated phone room is NOT acceptable.
 - Checking emails and texts in a golf cart in view of your playing partner is NOT discreet.
 - Holding your device under a table with your head down is NOT discreet.
 - Checking emails and texts while walking down the clubhouse hallways or golf course fairways or waiting for a car under the port cochere is NOT discreet.
- The Club has a long tradition of maintaining a low profile and protecting the privacy of its members and guests. The posting of images taken on Club property is inconsistent with that tradition.

Please note that CCF is strictly a non-tipping club and that smoking is prohibited in all areas of the Clubhouse.
